Almost 70% of the students agreed to the fact that curriculum has focus on skill development, analytical ability, applicability and practical orientation to real life situations. 70% of the students agreed that the faculty have adequate representation in curriculum planning and revision. Most of the students agreed that the distributions of credits to various courses are fair, just and even. 70% of the students opinioned that curriculum content is not a burden, it includes contemporary topics and it provides freedom and flexibility to adopt new techniques of teaching. Most of the students opined that the entire program is adequate and excellent.

Analysis Report on Teachers' Feedback 2019 – 2020 on Syllabus and its Transaction at the Institution (PG)

The teacher feedback actually functions as an employee satisfaction survey. Three fourth of the teachers strongly agreed that the curriculum is based on the needs of the stake holder. Most of the teachers agreed that course objectives and outcomes are well defined and clear to the faculty and students. Almost 90% of the teachers opinioned that sufficient no. of text / reference books are available for the courses. 86% of the teachers agreed that course curriculum has a good balance between theory and application. 97% of the teachers opined that the course curriculum has enhanced their interest in the subject. Almost half of the teachers strongly agreed of infrastructure facilities such as class rooms, reading rooms, labs, etc, are adequate and well maintained. Three fourth of the of the teachers strongly agreed that tests and examinations are conducted well in time, systematically and results announced in time. 79% of the teachers opinioned that curriculum provides opportunity for research and project related activities. Analysis Report on Alumni Feedback 2019–2020 on Syllabus and its Transaction at the Institution

Alumni feedback on syllabus encompasses a wide range of dimensions of the syllabus ranging from its employability potential to clearing competitive examinations. The feedback on syllabus focused on vary many areas. The curriculum of programs with their aspiration and career opportunities were rated by the alumni with moderate satisfaction. A third of the respondents claimed it excellent, another third considered it very good, while 22.9% of the respondents were hopeful about it. Only a few felt it average and satisfactory.

Based on various courses the curriculum, almost half of the respondents felt it very good while around one third of the respondents found it excellent. A quarter of the alumni were positive about it and only a few felt it average and satisfactory.

Regarding the curriculum in improving inters and interpersonal skills 25.3% of the alumni thought it excellent, while 28.6% felt it very good. While one third of the alumni claimed it good, only a few felt it average and satisfactory.

Regarding the global relevance of the syllabus, 18.2 % alumni felt it excellent, while one third of the respondents found it very good and good. 13.6% of the alumni felt it average and 1.9% satisfactory respectively.

Answering the project work, internship, lab experiments, etc, in curriculum 27.3% alumni opinioned it excellent while one third of the alumni felt it very good and 27.9% marked it good. Only 11% of the alumni felt it average and 2.6% satisfactory respectively.

About the course content one third of the alumni felt it excellent, while one third of them marking it very good and good. Only a few felt it average and satisfactory.

Regarding the curriculum in creating interests to pursue higher education one third of the respondents thought it excellent, while another one third of them considered it very good. A quarter of them claimed it good and only a few felt it average and satisfactory.

The course content in bridging the gap between academia and industry is rated by a quarter of the alumni as excellent, while 28.8% felt it very good and 37.9% felt it good. Only a few felt it average and satisfactory.

Judging the learning experience of the curriculum half of the alumni felt it excellent, while one third of them claimed it very good and good. Only a few felt it average and satisfactory.

Regarding academic ambiance of the college, 38.6% of the alumni opinioned it excellent, while 30.7% of them felt it very good and 20.9% felt it good. Only a few felt it average and satisfactory.


19.1% of the alumni rated extra and co-curricular activities in the college excellent, while a quarter of them felt it very good, good and average. Only a few felt it satisfactory.






How do you rate the Various courses in your curriculum 154 responses




How do you rate the curriculum in improving your inter and intra personal skills 154 responses




How do you rate your curriculum in relation to national and global trends and issues 154 responses




How do you rate the project work, internship, Lab experiments etc in your curriculum 154 responses




How do you rate the course content in fulfilling your expectations 153 responses


